Referring to your letter of March 8, 1954, regarding the H. J. Cox CO₂ wells in Mora County.

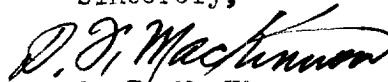
As per your kind suggestion, I wrote the Well Log Division at Socorro to see if they had any information on these wells but Mr. Bieberman writes they do not have the information I want and refers me to you.

I am seeking information on wells drilled in 1949, 1950 and 1951, not in 1925 or 1926. I feel sure two or three wells, at least, were drilled by H. J. Cox and/or Continental Frigidice and/or U. S. Frigidice, Inc. I have had much correspondence from Mr. Cox advising he was doing this drilling, some of it on stationary of U. S. Frigidice, some on Continental Frigidice and some on hotel stationary. Also he sent me a clipping from the Las Vegas Daily Optic newspaper of August 19, 1950, concerning the difficulties they were having on drilling the well under the name of Continental Frigidice.

What I am seeking is information about the dates of abandonment of these wells so will appreciate any information you can give me.
