Per our meeting on 8-14-14 in regards to the PLU 423, BOPCO has removed the heavy saturated soils from the release area located around the process equipment inside the firewall. The release area to the west of the containment firewall has been excavated to a depth of two feet. All contaminated soils excavated are being hauled to Lea Land for disposal. Per our agreement on 8-14-14 BOPCO will utilize micro blaze to spray the area around the process equipment and hand till where access allows. After the initial spray and till application is complete, one final dose of micro blaze will be applied before the area is backfilled. Upon completion of backfilling the release area a final closure report will be submitted electronically per your request. If you have any questions or concerns please let me know.
