Mike,

We have reviewed the request by Lime Rock Resources to utilize 45-mil LLDPE-R as the primary liner for the proposed All Thorn Multi-Well Fluid Management Pit. This request is conditionally approved. Those conditions are:

- 1. The primary liner must be installed as recommended by the manufacturer and tested using the Electrical Leak Location Survey as recommended by Mr. Frobel in the variance request.
- 2. The life span of the multi-well management pit is to be no longer than three (3) years.
- 3. The subgrade design of earthen material beneath and surrounding the pit must be approved by a Professional Engineer.

As the variance request was based on the use of 45-mil LLDPE-R rather than 30-mil flexible PVC, I will be requesting directly from Mr. Hicks that he provide an evaluation for the record comparing 45-mil LLDPE-R to 60-mil HDPE.
