Mr. Bratcher:

The following *Final Closure Report* serves as a condensed update on closure activities for the above referenced Site.

Background Information:

A ¼” hose to the high pressure kill switch ruptured. The valve was shut and the hose was replaced. The spill impacted approximately 1,525 sq. ft. of caliche well pad. The free standing fluid was recovered with a vacuum truck.

Remediation Activities:

EPI personnel mobilized on the site on July 13, 2015 to collect soil samples via hand auger to determine the vertical extent of contamination. A total of six (6) soil samples were collected from three (3) sample locations; SP1, SP2, SP3. Three (3) of the six (6) samples, each collected at one (1) foot bgs, were sent to Cardinal Labs in Hobbs, New Mexico, for testing. Laboratory analytical results indicate the release area is void of Benzene, BTEX, TPH, and Chloride concentrations in excess of NMOCD Recommended Remedial Action Levels (RRALs) of 10 mg/Kg, 50 mg/Kg, 5,000 mg/Kg, and 1,000 mg/Kg, respectively (reference *Figure 3* and *Table 2*).

The release area was excavated to a depth of approximately six (6) inches bgs. Approximately 42 tons of contaminated soil was excavated and hauled to a state approved facility for disposal.

Closure Activities:

With NMOCD approval the excavation was backfilled with approximately 42 tons of clean soil. All soil was free of rocks, clumps or deleterious material. The entire disturbed area was then contoured to blend with existing pad area and protected against wind/water erosion.









