



Cliff,

Your proposal for remediation of the above referenced release is approved. OCD agrees that the elevated chloride levels are likely residual from the original drilling pit. At this time, OCD requests that the proposed soil removal be limited to the caliche pad and not disturb the pit area. Please advise once remedial activities have been scheduled for this site.

OCD approval does not relieve the operator of liability should their operations fail to adequately investigate and remediate contamination that may pose a threat to ground water, surface water, human health or the environment. 
