Mr. Bratcher

We should have the trench characterization data in a week or so. We will use these data to select the location of 1-2 deep auger borings within the release footprint.

The abandoned well south of the site (17.29.8.231) is listed in OF-95 as

24.224	Stock	3565	33.88	24.2
17.29. 8.231	Stock	3617	92.7	90.13

The well was caved at 93 feet in 1971 and is not accessible now.

My guess is that we will find 90+ feet of dust dry cuttings, most of which will be clay.

Can you live with one boring at the “worst” place to complete the vertical delineation? I would like to cut cost if you think two borings is overkill – as I do.
