Subject: Government T Com #001 South Oil Tank

This is to inform you that Oxy Permian had a release at the Government T Com #001 South Oil Tank on December 18, 2016. Oxy released 100 bbls of produced water due to failure of a gasket on the manway cover. The preliminary report indicates that the leak measures 6' X 600' inside the containment on location. A vacuum truck recovered 60 bbls of produced water. The release is located in U/L C, Section 14, T20S, R28E in Eddy County, NM. Driving directions are not available at this time.
