you have different shapefile this this data, let me know. BLM treats medium karst areas are treated using the
strictest remedial levels in Table 1 regardless of depth to groundwater. NMSLO will also apply this standard.

The spill has been delineated to 600ppm chlorides, so delineation is complete. I don't think it will result in altering your remediation plan as written. Let me know if you have any question.
