Jim – I am forwarding this so Rob can see the attachment and now you have his email address. We got an email notification on 12/7 from Dakota Neel w/Concho that you were copied on, about a spill on the Windmill 32 Fed Com 4H.

I just spoke with Becky w/Concho and the release did not make it to the River. It was mainly an overspray, with most being on location. They picked up all the fluid they could get and went ahead and scraped up most of the impacted soil because the weather forecast was for precipitation over the weekend. We did get a light rain and some snow on Saturday, but the release did not make it into the Pecos.
