**Tim and Jennifer,**

We have received your closure report for **1RP-5399 Diamondback Tank Bat**, thank you. This closure is denied.

The remediation plan requires a scaled site map diagram with sample points clearly marked. Also, please include signed and dated C-141 (Pages 3-5) for a remediation plan. Please entitle your report Remediation-Deferral request, when you resubmit the report. The OCD will not close a release, where contaminants are left in place, due to close proximity to equipment. Sample point SW6 SW7, and BH2 BH4 will require a formal deferral request if you are looking to complete remediation during any future major well pad construction/alteration or final plugging and abandonment, whichever occurs first.
