All,

XTO is requesting an extension of the current 90 day deadline for submitting a remediation work plan or closure report required in 19.15.29.12.B.(1) NMAC at the Corral Canyon Central Tank Battery RP# 2RP-5466 . The spill occurred May 18, 2019 when a leaking valve caused a tank within a temporary lined container to overfill. Soils beneath containment and tank may have been impacted, however the tank and containment need to be removed before site assessment and remediation can begin. Regular updates of the operational activities have been provided to ensure that work begins as soon as the equipment is removed. To provide enough time to fully assess the site and conduct remediation work, XTO requests an extension of the current deadline until November 16, 2019.
