Yates Petroleum Corporation wishes to change 5-1/2" production casing cementing program to:

Cement first stage with Halliburton's "Zone Seal Cement". Will cover from TD of approximately 7400' to shoe of 8-5/8" casing at 3227' with Premium Plus "C" foamed with nitrogen. Cement weights will range from 13 ppg at TD to 10.5 ppg at shoe of 8-5/8" casing.

A stage packer will be set approximately 100' in the 8-5/8" x 5-1/2" annulus. Cement will be circulated to surface with Halliburton's Lite Premium Plus cement. Wt. 12.4 ppg, yld. 1.98 cubic ft/sx. Will tail in with 50 sx Premium Plus "C" with 2% calcium chloride.
