A test sub-pump was installed in December, 2002 and the well was pumped for seven weeks. When the sub-pump failed on January 30, 2003, economics would not justify continued production.

The equipment was pulled, and a CIBP was set above the open-hole Penn completion. Details are as follows:

3-06-2003 - Kill well/ND WH & NU BOP / TOH w/sub pmp; Run/set 7" CIBP @ 7150' w/h
3-07-2003 TIH / Circ pkr fluid / TOH LD 2-7/8" tbg; ND/NU DH FLNG/RR
3-12-2003 Contacted Jim Amos at BLM and gave 24 hour notice of intent to MIT.
3-13-2003 MIT performed; results = good; copy of chart attached
Pressured up to 525 psi, held for approx 43 minutes
Kerr-McGee witness was Steve Brannon; BLM witness Paul Swartz

Note: Past attempts to install artificial lift have failed due to high angle of wellbore (up to 35 degrees in some depths.) Due to low production rates/increased costs in artificial lift equipment, well has been TA'd. We continue to evaluate options for sidetracking, or identifying better performing artificial lift options.
