Materials have been removed from a production pit located just West of storage tank. Pit has not been declared and closure application has not been submitted. Fluids from pit have run out into pasture to the West for approx 100 yds. This probably occurred during removal of pit contents.

Load valve on storage tank is leaking. Violation Rule 50, Rule 13, and Rule 116

Comments on Inspection:

Observed roustabout crew excavating a production pit located on the North side of tank battery. Fluids were being brought out of pit and allowed to run out into pasture. Advised that no more

fluids were to be allowed to run out and that fluids that had been released would be required to be picked up, along with contaminated soils caused by release. No approval has been applied for or

granted for closure of this pit. Violation Rule 50, Rule 13, and Rule 116.

In the event that a satisfactory response is not received to this letter of direction by the "Corrective Action Due By:" date shown above, further enforcement will occur. Such enforcement may include this office applying to the Division for an order summoning you to a hearing before a Divison Examiner in Santa Fe to show cause why you should not be ordered to permanently plug and abandon this well. Such a hearing may result in imposition of CIVIL PENALTIES for your violation of OCD rules.
