1. <u>DIRECTIONS & EXISTING ROADS</u> (See PAGES 11 - 14)



From the Loco Hills Post Office ...
Go East 3.9 miles on US 82 to the equivalent of Mile Post 135.95
Then turn left and go North 1.2 miles on paved County Road 221 (Skelly)
Then turn right and go East 0.8 mile on a caliche road
Then turn right and go Southeast 0.2 mile to LINN's Hudson Federal #6 well
Fair's proposed pad overlaps the east side of the Hudson pad

This APD is also serving as a BLM road right-of-way application. Right-of-way will start at County Road 221 and end at the lease boundary. Right-of-way will cross Lot 2, SENW, & SWNE 18-17s-31e. Dimensions are 20' \times 4,224' (0.8 mile) = 1.94 acre.

Roads will be maintained to a standard at least equal to their present condition.

2. ROAD TO BE BUILT OR UPGRADED

No new road will be built. The proposed pad overlaps an existing water injection well pad. No realignment or widening of the existing road is needed. Upgrading will consist of repairing potholes with caliche.

3. EXISTING WELLS (See PAGE 13)

There are 169 oil, gas, injection, or disposal wells and 36 P & A wells within a one mile radius. There are no water wells within a mile.

4. PROPOSED PRODUCTION FACILITIES

A separator, two 300 barrel oil tanks, and two 400 barrel water tanks will be installed on the pad. Production equipment will be painted a flat Carlsbad tan. No off pad pipeline is planned. No power line is planned.

5. WATER SUPPLY

Water will be trucked from private land in Maljamar or Loco Hills.

6. CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS & METHODS

NM One Call (1-800-321-ALERT) and LINN Operating, Inc. (Allen Rambur @ (713) 470-8943 or (281) 840-1505) will be notified before construction starts. It appears two pipelines cross the pad. They will either be moved to the edge of the pad or buried deeper.

Southeast corner of the pad will be rounded off to avoid a wash. Southeast corner of the pad will extend no further than 120' from the center stake. North edge of the pad will be no more than 150' north of center stake. The top 6" of soil and brush will be stockpiled north of the pad. A closed loop drilling system will be used. Caliche will be bought and hauled from an existing approved caliche pit. Dirt contractor will be responsible for caliche.

7. WASTE DISPOSAL

All trash will be placed in a portable trash cage. It will be hauled to a county landfill. There will be no trash burning. Contents of the mud tanks will be hauled to state approved disposal sites. Human waste will be disposed of in chemical toilets and hauled to an approved dump station.

8. ANCILLARY FACILITIES

There will be no air strip or camp. Camper trailers will be on location for the company man, tool pusher, or mud logger.

9. WELL SITE LAYOUT

See Pages 14 and 15 for depictions of the well pad, reserve pit, trash cage, access onto the location, parking, living facilities, and rig orientation.

10. RECLAMATION

Reclamation will consist of reducing the pad footprint to a tear drop shape around the pump, anchors, and production equipment; while leaving enough space for work overs. Disturbed areas will be contoured to a natural shape and no steeper than 3:1. Soil and brush will be evenly spread over disturbed areas. Seeded areas will be ripped or harrowed. A BLM approved seed mix will be sown in a BLM approved manner. Once the well is plugged, then the remainder of the pad will be similarly reclaimed.

11. SURFACE OWNER

All construction will be on lease and on BLM.

12. OTHER INFORMATION
