Additional location work will have to be done and the new area will be arched by Boone Archaeological Services and the original pits will be reworked to fit the new location. The Drilling and Multi-point Surface Use & Operations Plan will remain the same.

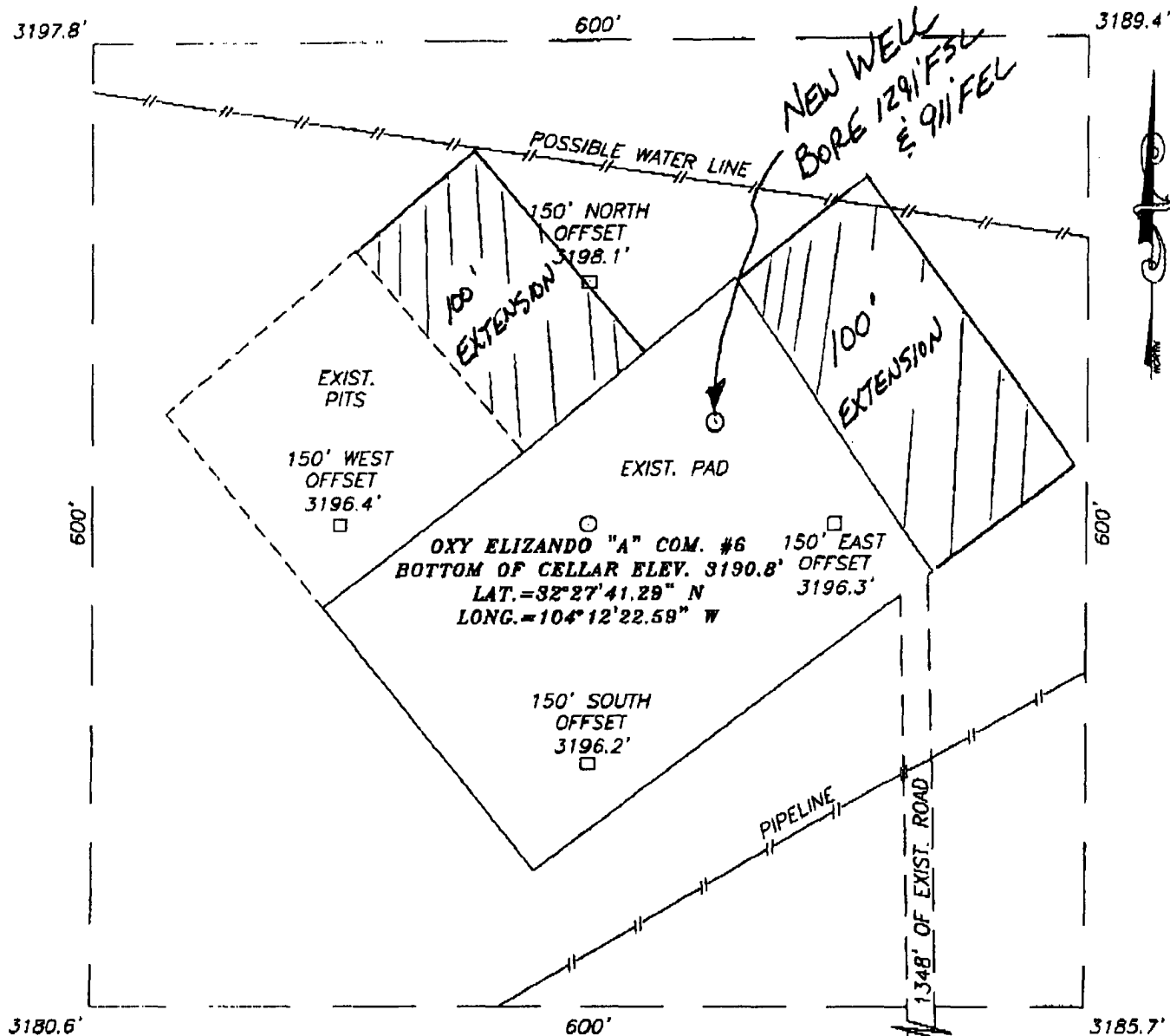

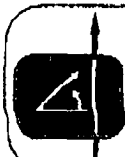

Findings (see Field Office requirements to determine area to be reviewed during records search):

LA 26182, 29362, 78119, 75562, 131104, 131108, 7358 and 75857 are within 1.0 mile.

b. Description of Undertaking:

The project consists an extension of an existing pad 61 feet to the north and 79 feet east of the original 600 feet by 600 feet then rotating it approximately 45 degrees in order to accommodate another drill hole. This formed two triangle shaped areas outside of the previous pad survey (See attached map), one estimated to be 150 feet by 200 feet by 200 feet and the other 350 feet by 275 feet by 275 feet. Survey were estimated on this basis. Impact acres are unknown and are estimates.

c. Environmental Setting (NRCS soil designation; vegetative community; etc.):

Topography: Small hill with an overall slope to the south and east with areas of exposed caliche and gravel.

Vegetation: Overall groundcover is approximately 30% and consists primarily of catclaw, acacia, mesquite, broom snakeweed, littleleaf horsebrush, various grasses and other flora.

NRCS: Reeves-Gypsum land-Cottonwood association: Loamy soils that are very shallow to moderately deep over gypsum beds, and Gypsum lands.

d. Field Methods: (transect intervals; crew size; time in field, etc.):

Transects: Parallel grid spaced 15 meters or less.

Crew Size: One

Time in Field: 1.0 hour.

e. Artifacts Collected (?): None

17. Cultural Resource Findings:

a. Identification and description: One isolated manifestation (IM) at UTM Zone 13, 574628E, 3591789N consists of one smashed and rusted metal can, 3 5/8" in diameter, 4 1/2" long, match top filled with hand solder.

b. Evaluation of significance of Each Resource: Data considered exhausted by recording.

18. Management Summary (Recommendations):

Archaeological clearance a pad extension for the OXY Elizondo "A" Com well No. 6 for OXY USA INC. as presently staked is recommended. If cultural resources are encountered at any time all activity should cease and the BLM Archaeologist notified immediately.
