Pursuant to <u>Pit and Below-Grade Tank Guidelines</u> as published November 1, 2004 by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division.

Allstate Environmental Services was contracted by Mack Energy Corp. to commence closure activities of the drilling pits at the Red Lake Sand Unit #60 lease in Eddy County on February 17, 2005.
