Operator,

A Form C-141 with a remediation proposal for the above referenced well site, has been received by the NMOCD District 2 office. To confirm our conversation during a meeting at the well site on April 14,2005, the following stipulations apply to the remediation of this well site.

Impacted soils are to be removed and hauled to an NMOCD approved disposal. The initial excavation will remove approximately 4 to 6 inches of soil from the impacted area. After soil removal, samples are to be obtained and submitted to an approved lab for analysis. A background sample of the playa will also be obtained at this time.

The results of these samples will determine if further excavation is required.
