13. Describe Proposed or Completed Operation: Clearly state all pertinent details, including estimated starting date of any proposed work and approximate duration thereof. If the proposal is to deepen directionally or recompleat horizontally, give subsurface locations and measured and true vertical depths of all pertinent markers and zones. - EOG Resources, Inc contracted Talon/LPE to do reclamation of the closed drilling pit at the Corral Draw 9 Federal No.1, an active well location.
- The north side of the location measuring approximately 195-feet long by 50-feet wide was scraped and was placed under the liner of the drilling pit area. A 40-feet long by 40-feet wide area off the northwest corner of the location showing chloride impacts was excavated to a depth of 8-feet deep and also placed under the liner of the drilling pit area. Chloride samples were taken from the bottom and sidewalls of the excavation for confirmation of completion. Subsequently a 20 mil liner was placed in the bottom of the excavation. The excavation was backfilled using soil from a local location and contoured to match the terrain.
- The surface of the closed drilling pit area was bladed to prepare for the installation of a liner. Rock and debris was deep buried into the drilling pit area. A composite 20 millimeter liner measuring 180-feet long by 150-feet wide was installed over the closed drilling pit area. The edges of the liner was keyed a minimum of 3-feet deep into a trench excavated at the boundaries of the closed drilling pit area.
- New soil was transported to the site from a nearby location. A minimum of 2-foot of soil was placed over the top of the 20 mil liner on the drilling pit. The soil lift was contoured to match the surrounding terrain.
- The location was seeded on 5/11/12 using the recommended BLM seed mixture #2.
