The line will carry approximately 300 bwpd at 100 psi.

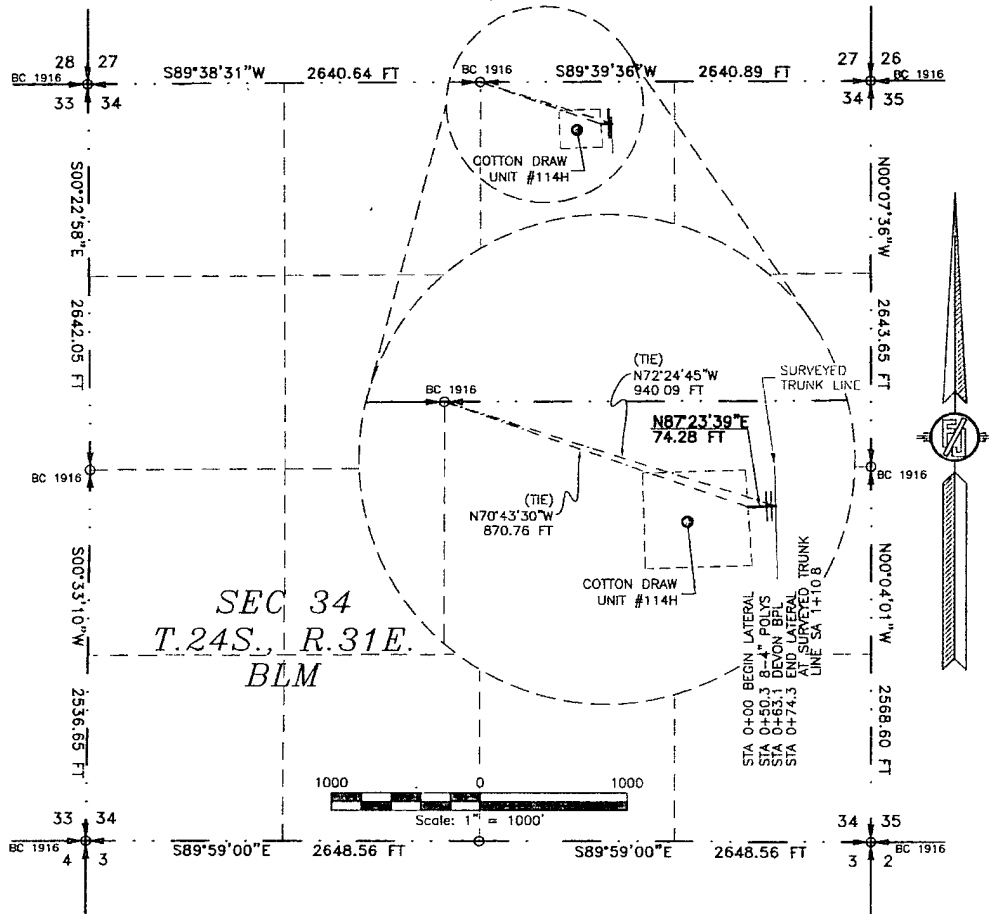

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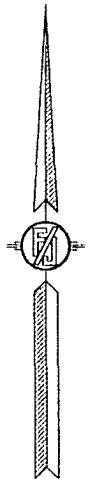

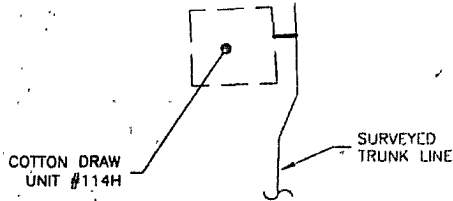
