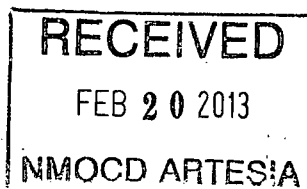

Your Application for Permit to Drill (APD), approved March 3, 2009, for the Whitehorse Federal Well No. 4, located SH: 1430 feet FSL and 260 feet FEL (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$) and BH: 990 feet FSL and 330 feet FEL (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$) Sec. 25, T. 15 S., R. 28 E., Chaves County, New Mexico, Federal lease NM-0560397 has expired March 3, 2011 because drilling has not commenced within two years of the approval date.

If the well has not been spudded, but site construction activities have occurred, please contact this office at the above telephone number for surface reclamation instructions.

If you wish to drill this well at a later date, please submit a complete application (1 original and 5 copies). Since the original APD has expired, the resubmitted APD will be subject to all of the processing requirements including the 30-day posting requirement. Please note on the resubmitted APD that it was previously approved and we will review the expired file for information which will expedite the processing.
