Initially 35bbls of produced water were released from a discharge water line we were able to recover 32bbls with a vacuum truck. All free fluid has been recovered. Tetra Tech will sample the spill site area to delineate any possible contamination from the release and we will present a work plan to the NMOCD for approval prior to any significant remediation work.
