

Lightning struck the spare water tank. Replaced water tank.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

Initially 100bbls of produced water were released due to a lightning strike on one of our fiberglass tanks. We were able to recover 90bbls of produced water. The entire release was contained inside the lined facility. All free fluids have been recovered. Any contaminated gravel has been removed, the liner has been washed, and we have replaced with clean gravel as necessary. This facility has been returned to its prior condition.
