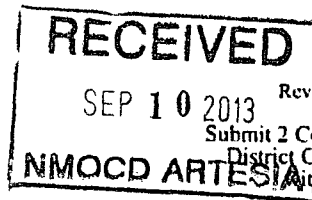

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*

While replacing the H pump at the SRO 103, the transfer pump kicked on at the F.U.N. #001H battery causing it to run against the closed inlet valve at the SRO 103.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

Initially 70bbls of produced water were released due to a closed inlet valve. We were able to recover 65bbls of produced water with a vacuum truck. The entire release was contained inside the lined facility. All free fluid has been recovered. Contaminated gravel has been removed and we have replaced with fresh gravel as necessary. This location has been returned to its prior condition.
