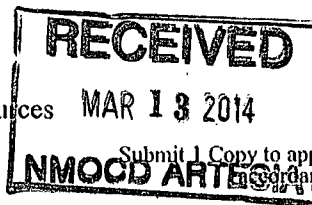

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*
The FWKO micro-switch malfunctioned and dumped oil to the flare.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*
The majority of standing fluid was contained in the bermed area around flare. A small area of standing fluid was in the pasture southeast of the flare. An overspray area affected the pasture approximately (30,000 square feet) and pad northeast of the flare. A vacuum truck was dispatched to pick up standing fluid.
