1. 4 1/2" CIBP set on wire line at 7800' with 35' of cement on top.
2. Ran jet cutter and shot 4 1/2" casing off at 6300'. LD 4 1/2" casing.
3. Spotted 55 Sx Cl H cement thru tubing from 6375' to 6225' (150' plug).
4. Spotted 35 Sx Cl H cement thru tubing from 4900' to 4800' (100' plug).
5. Spotted 35 Sx Cl H cement thru tubing from 3716' to 3616' (100' plug).
6. Spotted 35 Sx Cl H cement thru tubing from 2568' to 2468' (100' plug).
7. Spotted 25 Sx Cl H cement thru tubing from 75' to surface (75' plug).
8. 10 ppg mud was placed between plugs.
9. Steel plate was welded on top of 8 5/8" casing stub and (OVER)

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, state or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 1: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations of Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or regional office for specific instructions.

Item 2: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices. In submitting such proposals and reports should include reasons for the abandonment; data on any signs of present production, seepage or other zones with present significant fluid potentials not sealed off by cement or otherwise; depths (top and bottom) and method of placement of cement plugs; mud or other material placed below; between and above plugs; amount, size, method of packing of any casing, liner or tubing pulled and the depth by which any bit in the hole; method of closing top of well; and also well site conditioned for final inspection looking to approval of the abandonment.
