#### CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL FOR TWO FLARING SUNDRY NOTICES

- 1. Within 15 days after production testing is completed, a copy of test results along with the total amount of gas flared will be submitted to the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) Las Cruces District Office. This report will also be furnished to the Mineral Management Service pursuant to NTL-4A. NTL-4A allows faring for 30 days or a production limit of 50 mmcf of gas, whichever occurs first. Flaring greater than 30 days or 50 mmcf requires approval in the form of a Sundry Notice. Royalty will be due on any amount of the gas flared that exceeds this threshold.
- 2. Two weeks prior to flaring, HEYCO will contact the BLM Las Cruces District Office to coordinate the biological survey for aplomado falcons as required by the U. S. Fish and Wildlife Service Biological Report.
- HEYCO will also contact all affected neighbors and landowners and inform them of all activities that
  will take place, what to expect and what precautions will be taken to ensure the health and safety of
  all.
- 4. HEYCO will ensure protection of the Butterfield Trail and cultural resources as specified in the Resource Management Plan Amendment.
