The original pit area will also be re-excavated to a depth where representative samples of the sides and bottom of the excavation indicate all soils with TPH levels above 5000 ppm have been removed. A trench will be installed. The trench will be lined with a 12-mil impervious liner and the excavated material will be placed on top of the liner and encapsulated with a 20-mil impervious liner. The trench will be covered and contoured with three feet of soil or like material capable of supporting native plant growth to prevent erosion and ponding of rainwater. The excavated areas will be backfilled with clean soil and all of the areas will be reseeded in the spring
