Well: Brushy "12" Federal Well No. 1 (API No. 30-015-25416) Unit N
Brushy "12" Federal Well No. 4 (API No. 30-015-25604) Unit L

Lease: Brushy "12A" Federal Lease (Federal Lease No. NM-11039)
Description: SW/4 NW/4 of Section 12, Township 26 South, Range 29 East, NMPM;

Wells: Brushy "12A" Federal Well No. 1 (API No. 30-015-25615) Unit E

Due to the diversity of ownership, production from each of the above-described wells shall be separately metered prior to commingling.

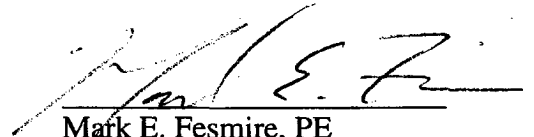
