AFFIDAVIT OF OWNERSHIP OF OIL

TO: THE PERMIAN CORPORATION

Hugh Meyer, of lawful age, being first duly sworn, deposes and states as follows:

That he is the agent of Burleson & Huff (hereinafter called "Producer") and is duly qualified and authorized to make this affidavit and fully cognizant of the facts herein set out and that this affidavit is made for the purpose of securing one hundred percent (100%) payment for the oil hereinafter described.

That during the month of January, 1962, Producer sold to The Permian Corporation a total of Forty (40) net barrels of recovered crude oil which had previously been purchased from The Permian Corporation during the month of November, 1961;

that said crude oil sold to The Permian Corp. had been used by Producer as circulating oil in the completion of, and has now been recovered from the well

No. 1 located upon the following described lease:
Angell-State Lease, Section 21, T-19-S, R-28-E, Undesignated pool.
Eddy County, New Mexico.

WHEREFORE, Producer asserts that it is entitled to the full one hundred percent (100%) payment for said oil without deduction of any kind for royalties, taxes, overriding royalties, oil payments, or any other obligations.

THEREFORE, please take notice that payment for the amount of oil stated should be directly to Producer without such deductions for the full value of said oil so purchased and Producer will indemnify The Permian Corporation of, from and against any and all claims which may be asserted by others as a result of such payment by The Permian Corporation to Producer.
