Devon Energy respectfully requests to change the lead cement slurry for the Cotton Draw 223H. We're keeping the tail slurry the same, we'll run a lead slurry that will allow us to not need a DV tool and 2-stage cement job unless hole conditions dictate 2 stages are needed, in that case we'll use what the original APD has called out. We will have 500' of tie-back into previous casing shoe. And use 10% excess over the fluid caliper when its pumped at TD of the well.

DV tool depth(s) will be adjusted based on hole conditions and cement volumes will be adjusted proportionally. DV tool will be set a minimum of 50 feet below previous casing and a minimum of 200 feet above current shoe. Lab reports with the 500 psi compressive strength time for the cement will be onsite for review.

Sundry Approved and the Original COA still stand with the following modification:

1. The minimum required fill of cement behind the 5-1/2 inch production casing is:

Proposed Primary Cement Job as follows:

- Cement should tie-back at least 500 feet into previous casing string. Operator shall provide method of verification. **Excess calculates to 21% - Additional cement may be required.**

Proposed Contingency Cement Job if experience loss returns and hole condits warrant a two stage job as follows:

Operator has proposed DV tool at depth of 5,250', but will adjust cement proportionately if moved. DV tool shall be set a minimum of 50' below previous shoe and a minimum of 200' above current shoe. Operator shall submit sundry if DV tool depth cannot be set in this range. If an ECP is used, it is to be set a minimum of 50' below the shoe to provide cement across the shoe. If it cannot be set below the shoe, a CBL shall be run to verify cement coverage.

- a. First stage to DV tool:

- Cement to circulate. If cement does not circulate, contact the appropriate BLM office before proceeding with second stage cement job. Operator should have plans as to how they will achieve circulation or approved top of cement on the next stage. **Excess calculates to 17% - Additional cement may be required.**

- b. Second stage above DV tool:

- Cement should tie-back at least 500 feet into previous casing string. Operator shall provide method of verification.
