The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division District 2 Office (OCD) is in receipt of a Final Report C-141 and a report outlining actions taken to remediate a release of produced fluids that occurred at the above referenced site. The release was discovered by OCD personnel on 3/16/2005.

Stipulations for approval of the Final Report C-141 are as listed below:

- As per the Final Remediation Report, submitted by your agent, Environmental Site Assessors LLC, the remediation site is to have samples obtained for analysis twice over the next 6-month period. Based on a 3-month interval, the approximate sampling dates would be April 25, 2006 and July 25, 2006.
- If sample analyses indicate contamination levels to be above acceptable levels, further remediation actions may be required.
- Notify the OCD District 2 office 24 hours prior to obtaining samples where analysis of samples obtained are to be submitted to the OCD.

Please be advised that NMOCD acceptance and/or approval of documents does not relieve the operator of liability should their operations have failed to adequately investigate and remediate contamination that pose a threat to ground water, surface water, human health or the environment. In addition, NMOCD acceptance and/or approval does not relieve the operator of responsibility for compliance with any other federal, state, local laws and/or regulations.
