

Wells were shut off, the union on the pump was repaired and all produced water was recovered using a vacuum truck. Depth to Ground Water: > 100' (approximately 225', per ChevronTexaco Trend Map), Wellhead Protection Area: No, Distance to Surface Water Body: >1000', SITE RANKING IS 0. Based on the battery being lined/bermed, all of the released water recovered; Yates Petroleum Corporation requests closure.
