Dear Mr. Herrell,

Devon Energy unintentionally drilled our Apache 25 Fed #16 on the wrong location. The well was permitted to be drilled at 2310' FSL & 1980' FWL of Sec 25, T22S, R30E. It was actually drilled at 1980' FSL & 660' FWL of the same Section. The mistake was unintentional and the following is a description of events causing the error.

The well was originally staked at 1980' FSL & 660' FWL after I had a discussion with Craig Cranston of the BLM solids minerals group regarding drilling in the Potash barren portion of Section 25. He had indicated that this was a location he would be willing to approve. We staked it and performed an archaeological survey for the location and submitted the APD to the BLM. Craig met with a Potash review group to discuss permitted locations in Potash areas and decided to have us move the location to 1980' FWL between the previously drilled Apache 25 Fed #12 and Apache 25 Fed #13. We restaked the 25 #16 at 2310' FSL & 1980' FWL and kept the well name the same. The APD was modified in the BLM office with a red pen denoting the new footage calls and a new C-102 staking plat and arch survey were submitted. This APD was approved by the BLM and was sent to the field to have the location built to prepare for drilling. At that time, Devon's representative met with the location contractor and incorrectly pointed out the location at the original stake. The location was built and the rig was moved in and drilled to TD and the well was completed. At that time, I traveled to the location and noticed that the well was not located between the #12 and #13 wells and determined that it was probably at the originally staked spot. A GPS was taken to the location to confirm this and the issue was brought up to Mr. Tony Harrell with the BLM.

Devon respectfully requests approval of our location of the Apache 25 Fed #16 well as drilled at 1980' FSL & 660' FWL of Sec 25, T22S, R30E, in Eddy County, NM.
