This release was caused when an alarm malfunctioned due to loss of electricity causing the tank to overflow. Vacuum trucks were immediately dispatched to recover all standing fluid.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*
This release was contained within a falcon lined facility. Vacuum trucks were dispatched to recover all standing fluids. The liner and equipment were pressure washed. Concho will have the spill site inspected to determine if any possible contamination occurred from the release and we will present a remediation work plan to the NMOCD for approval prior to any significant remediation work.
