Yates Petroleum Corporation plans to plug and abandon this well as follows:

1. MIRU safety equipment as needed. No casing recovery will be attempted.
2. Set a CIBP at 6764' with 35' cement on top. This puts a plug over the open perforations.
3. Perforate 5-1/2" casing at 4364' and spot a 35 sx Class "C" cement plug from 4264'-4364'. This puts a 100' plug across the Delaware top, inside and outside casing. WOC and tag plug.
4. Perforate at 4233' and spot a 30 sx Class "C" cement plug from 4133'-4233', across the intermediate casing shoe, inside and outside the casing. WOC and tag plug.
5. Spot a 25 sx Class "C" cement plug from 800'-900', across the surface casing shoe, inside and outside the casing. WOC and tag plug.
6. Spot a 25 sx Class "C" cement plug from 150' up to the surface.
7. Remove all surface equipment, weld dry hole marker and clean location as per regulations.

NOTE: Yates Petroleum Corporation will use steel pits and no earth pits

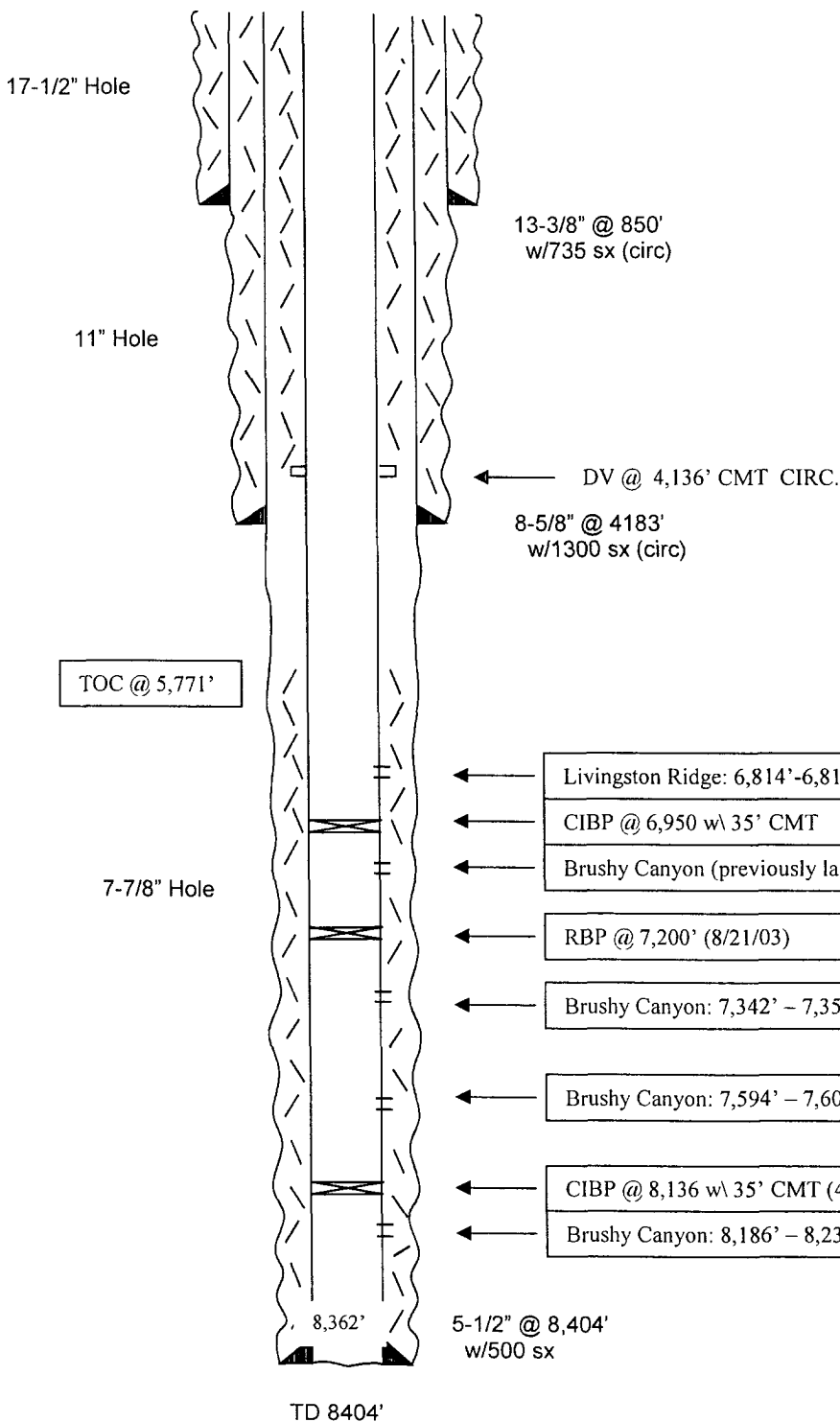

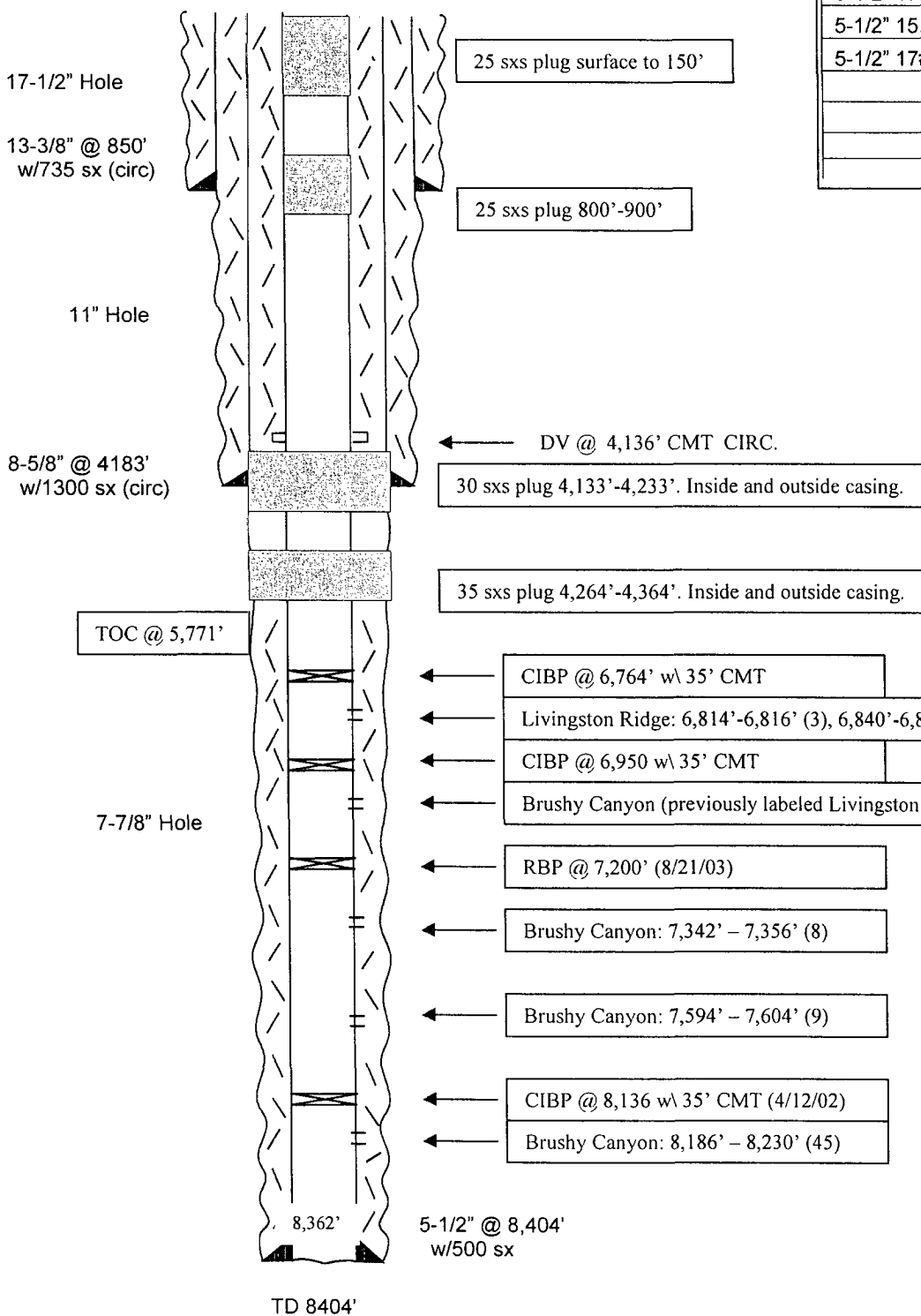
