Operator,

The above referenced well has been identified by a New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (OCD) field inspection as having an unlined, unregistered pit on site. The inspection was performed on January 29, 2007, resulting in the issuance of a Letter of Violation (LOV # 020307). This pit is in violation of Rule 19.15.2.50 NMAC which, effective April 15, 2004, requires pits to be lined and registered with the OCD.

On February 13, 2007, the OCD District 2 office received a Form C-144 registration for the pit. The C-144 was signed and submitted by your representative/agent, Geri Cooley.

Please submit a work plan proposal for remediation and/or removal of contaminants that may be present in or around the pit. The work plan is to be formulated based on site ranking, contaminant identification and delineation, OCD rules and guidelines, and any other State, Local and/or Federal laws and/or regulations as may be applicable. This work plan proposal is to be submitted to the OCD District 2 office no later than February 28, 2007.
