In reference to the above noted APDs, the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (NMOCD) will require (in part) that drilling mud samples from the flow line be sampled every 100' in order to determine chloride levels during the drilling of the <u>Capitan Reef section</u> of the well bore. Results are to be submitted to our office before drilling to total depth of the well bore. Please note that the Capitan Reef section is to be drilled with a fresh water mud.
