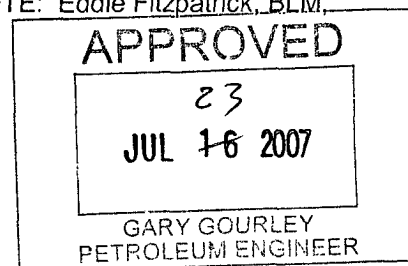

Set cement retainer at 1050' and pumped 285 sxs cement, circulated to surface. Dumped 5 sxs cement on top of retainer. TOC 991'. Pumped cement plug from 373' to surface. Installed P&A marker and backfilled cellar. NOTE: Eddie Fitzpatrick, BLM, witnessed plugging.
