ConocoPhillips requests approval to isolate the existing perforations with a composite BP set @ +/- 6400'; add perforations within the Middle Brushy Canyon of the Delaware formation, and return well to production.

The newly perforated interval will be 6303-6333' @ 2 spf+1 (61 total perfs).

Once the new perforations have been evaluated, it is possible the current perfs will be added back into the active wellbore.
