

Heater treater was found leaking upon arrival at location. All production switched through alternate heater treater. Release contaminated small area of location outside of berm around heater treater. Release was approximately 4 bbls. All contaminated materials, approximately 24 cubic yards, were excavated down to clean soil and hauled to CRI for disposal. Contaminated materials were replaced with clean soil and gravel. Repairs were made to heater treater and berm around heater treater was rebuilt. No further corrective actions were required.
