Additional Comments: The pit was excavated to a depth of 12' BGS. The North, East, and West walls had approximately 4' of soil excavated from them. At this point these 3 walls of the floor were sampled and lab results show them to be below the 300ppm OS required by NMOCD. The south wall had another 4' of soil excavated from it. It was then retested and lab results show it to be below the 300ppm of chlorides as required by NMOCD.
