1. Nipple up BOP equipment and test August 27, 2003.
2. Directionally drill 8-3/4" hole from 1,650' to 10,266'.
3. RU Schlumberger and run logs.
4. Run 5-1/2", 17 #/ft, N-80 8-rd New API casing to 10,263'. DV stage tool at 8,698'.
5. RU Schlumberger. Cement casing w/ 410 sxs PVL + 0.2% antifoam agent + 0.2% Dispersant + 0.3% Uniflac-S + 0.4% Retarder + 5 pps gilsonite extender. Flush to float collar and bump plug. Floats held. Drop bomb and open DV tool. Circulate approximately 30 bbls cement off top of stage tool. WOC 8 hours. Cement second stage w/ 1590 sxs 35:65 POZ + 5% Salt + 6% bentonite + 0.2% Uniflac-S + 0.2% antifoam agent lead cement followed by 300 sxs Class "H" neat cement as tail. Flush to DV tool and bumped plug. Job complete 2:30 a.m. October 6, 2003. WOC.
6. Rig down Patterson-UTI Rig #55. Waiting on completion rig.
