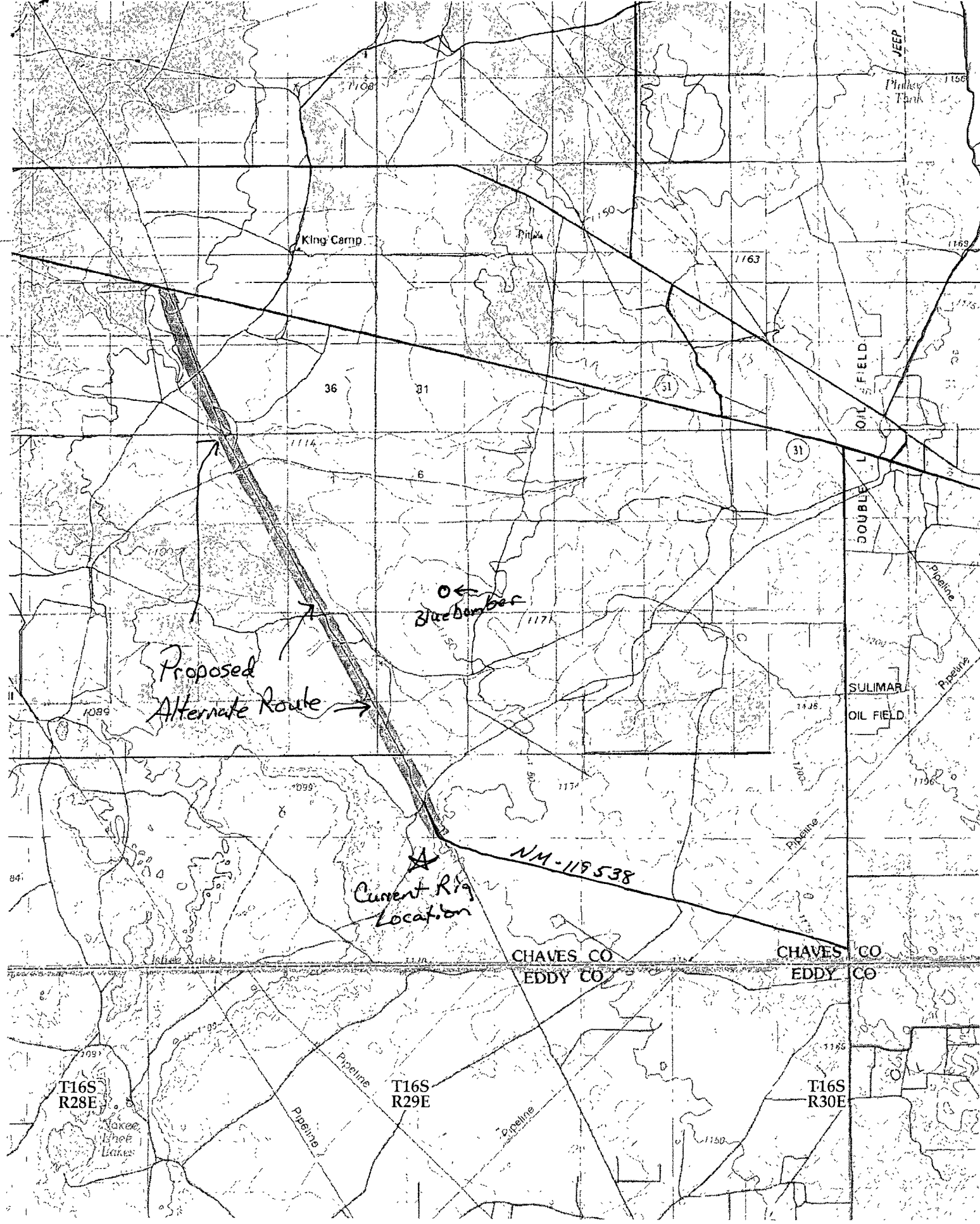

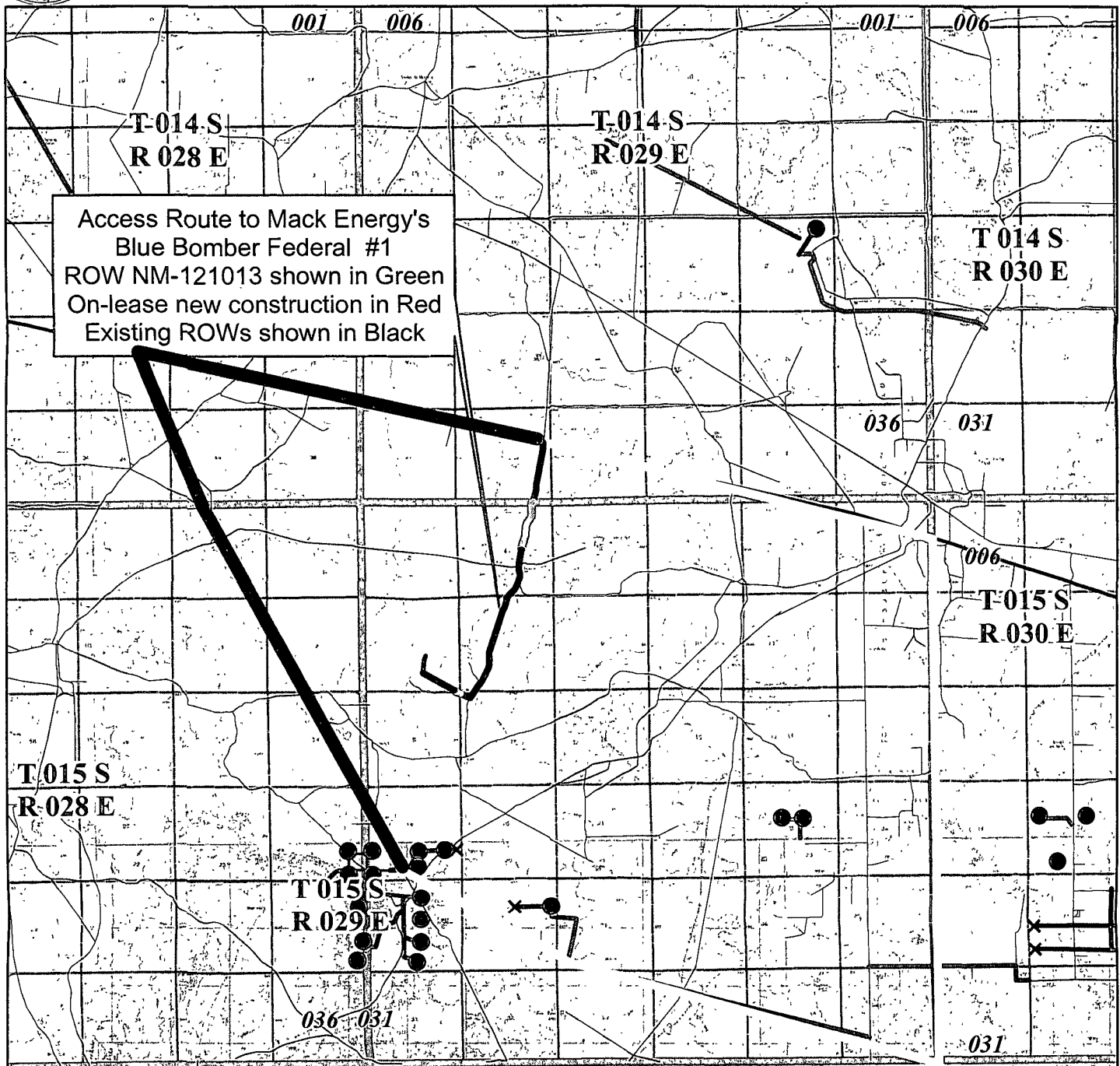

# ROW NM-121013 Mack Energy Corporation

On October 21, 2008, Mack Energy was granted ROW NM-121013 to access the Blue Bomber Federal #1. Mack planned to move the drill rig, route shown in yellow, upon existing ROWs and County roads to the starting point of NM-121013. Obstacles along the yellow route prompted Mack to file a sundry notice seeking to move the drill rig along the magenta colored route. That route also consists of existing ROWs and county roads. As this is a one time move upon existing roads the proposal is determined casual use 43 CFR 3150.0-5(b) and appropriately approved through this sundry notice.
