Tailed w/400 sx (532 cf) "C" cmt w/2% Cacl2 & 1/4# S/F. Circ 124 sx cmt to pit. Cmt job witnessed by Jerry Blakely with the BLM. On 2/7/08, pressure tested 8-5/8" csg to 500-psi for 30 min - OK.

Drilled 7-7/8" hole to TD3655' on 2/13/09 & set 5-1/2" 17# J-55 production csg @ 3645' w/PBTD @ 3603'. On 2/14/09. cmted w/lead 400 sx (712 cf) "C" cmt w/5% salt. 0.3% FL-200. & 1/4# super flake & tailed w/350 sx (462 cf) cl "C" cmt w/0.3% FL-200. Circ 185 sx cmt to pit. Released drilling rig on 2/14/09. Plan to pressure test 5-1/2" csg during completion operations.
