The Marilyn Federal #1 was plugged on 4/18/01. It appears as though a 3160-5 was never filed. Pits were filled and location cleared of debris, leveled and restored as near as possible to natural state. This is notice of final abandonment.

Note; all surface reclamation, filling of pits, etc was done immediatly after well was plugged, only the 3160-5 was never filed, an oversight on our part.
