OCD-ARTESIA

Each grouping of wells with identical ownership shall have continuous recording allocation gas meters installed prior to compression and sales. Within each identically owned set of wells, allocation of gas production and sales shall be according to periodic well tests. Oil production shall not be commingled under this order.

The measurement and sales point for commingled gas may occur off lease. The producer is responsible for notifying the transporter of this commingling authority.

The operator shall notify the Artesia district office of the Division prior to implementation of the commingling process.
