Dear Ms. Brown or to Whom It May Concern:

In regards to the above, the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (NMOCD) has yet to receive a **complete set** of electric logs run for each well. In addition, the NMOCD is also lacking **all** required federal regulatory reports dated after August 29<sup>th</sup>, 2003 requesting to drill deeper on the Chiricahua well and **all** required federal regulatory reports dated after August 13, 2003 requesting to lay a 'fast line' on the Mescalero well.

Please refer to the NMOCD's Rules and Regulations 1105.A and 1128.A.

Rule 1128.A, pertains to regulatory forms required by the NMOCD on Federal lands.

As you may remember, I have contacted your office by phone numerous times in December of 2003 and as of this date, Threshold Development Corporation has failed to meet NMOCD's requirements.

Failure to comply with NMOCD's Rules and Regulations with this matter may result in civil penalties being imposed.
