

Dear Mr. Amos:

Pursuant to the State of New Mexico regulatory requirements for permanent closure of drilling pads, please be advised Nadel and Gussman Permian, LLC, (NGP) has completed its final reclamation of the Major Gant Federal No. 1 (Major Gant) drilling pad and associated access road located in U/L N S12 T21S, R21E, 660' FSL, 2160' FWL of Eddy County, New Mexico. Final reclamation seeding of the reclaimed pad, access road and associated areas with BLM Seed Mix No. 1 was completed on 1 September 2010.

Based on your final inspection of the site on 19 August 2010, NGP had eliminated the *African Rue* present at the time of reclamation activities by burning 31 plants prior to their pods opening which were visible at the time, bagging the charred contents and disposing of them as directed by the Carlsbad Soil and Water Conservation District (CSWCD) office in Carlsbad. In the event of future outbreaks of this noxious weed at the Major Gant location, NGP has participated in the CSWCD eradication program.

Final remediation of the Major Gant is commensurate with existing topography and terrain relief features (contouring) so as to return it to its "near-as" previous condition, including contouring and ditching for prevailing winds and severe erosive conditions during excessive precipitous events. NGP was also fortunate to have had rainfall in the area at the time of closure such that the water diversion ditches are now commensurate with local drainage patterns in the area.
