NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DRILL

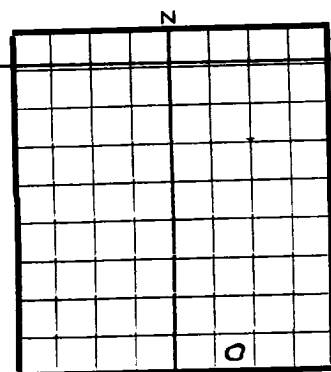

We propose to drill well with drilling equipment as follows:

The status of a bond for this well in conformance with Rule 39 of the General Rules and Regulations of the Commission is as follows: Market Bond

We propose to use the following strings of casing and to land or cement them as indicated:

Table with 7 columns: SIZE OF HOLE, SIZE OF CASING, WEIGHT PER FOOT, NEW OR SECOND HAND, DEPTH, LANDED OR CEMENTED, SACKS CEMENT. It lists two casing strings: one 10" hole with 8 5/8" casing (28 lb) to 450' depth, and another 8" hole with 7" casing (20 lb) to 1675' depth, both cemented.

If changes in the above plan become advisable we will notify you before cementing or landing casing. We estimate that the first productive oil or gas sand should occur at a depth of about 1750 feet.
